Lottery Heritage funding will be applied for although there is no idea of the cost yet. A Feasibility Report was mentioned and the Parish Council asked if am electronic copy could be provided. A Business Plan cannot be completed until it is known what the community wants. A survey is ready to go out but Birch InSpire would like the views of the Parish Council before it is sent out. Parking and access was raised as a serious concern. A meeting is scheduled with the Diocese at the end of June where an extension of another six months will be asked for. The Parish Council were thanked for their time and for listening.
