#### 19/11. CHAIRMAN'S WELCOME.

## 19/13. MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING.

#### 19/16. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION.

### 19/17. PROGRESS CHECK.

 Channel Sweeping – during autumn CBC concentrate on clearing leaves and sometimes postpone other road clearing duties, cleaning schedules resume as normal in January.  Vehicles blocking the highway leading to St Peters Church; a list of the offending registration numbers has been sent to the North Essex Parking Partnership.

An application for funding has been submitted to the Community Initiatives Fund and a decision will be made when the panel meets at the end of September
